

Palaeogeographic Maps of Iraq

A **palaeogeographic database for Iraq**, consisting of maps from the Precambrian to Recent, based on the sequence stratigraphic framework of Sharland et al. (2001, 2014). It includes **92 sequences** that are defined, with a map for each **highstand, transgressive, lowstand** and **maximum flood systems tracts**.

Cambridge Carbonates palaeogeographic maps covering Northern Arabia have been developed progressively over the last 25 years.

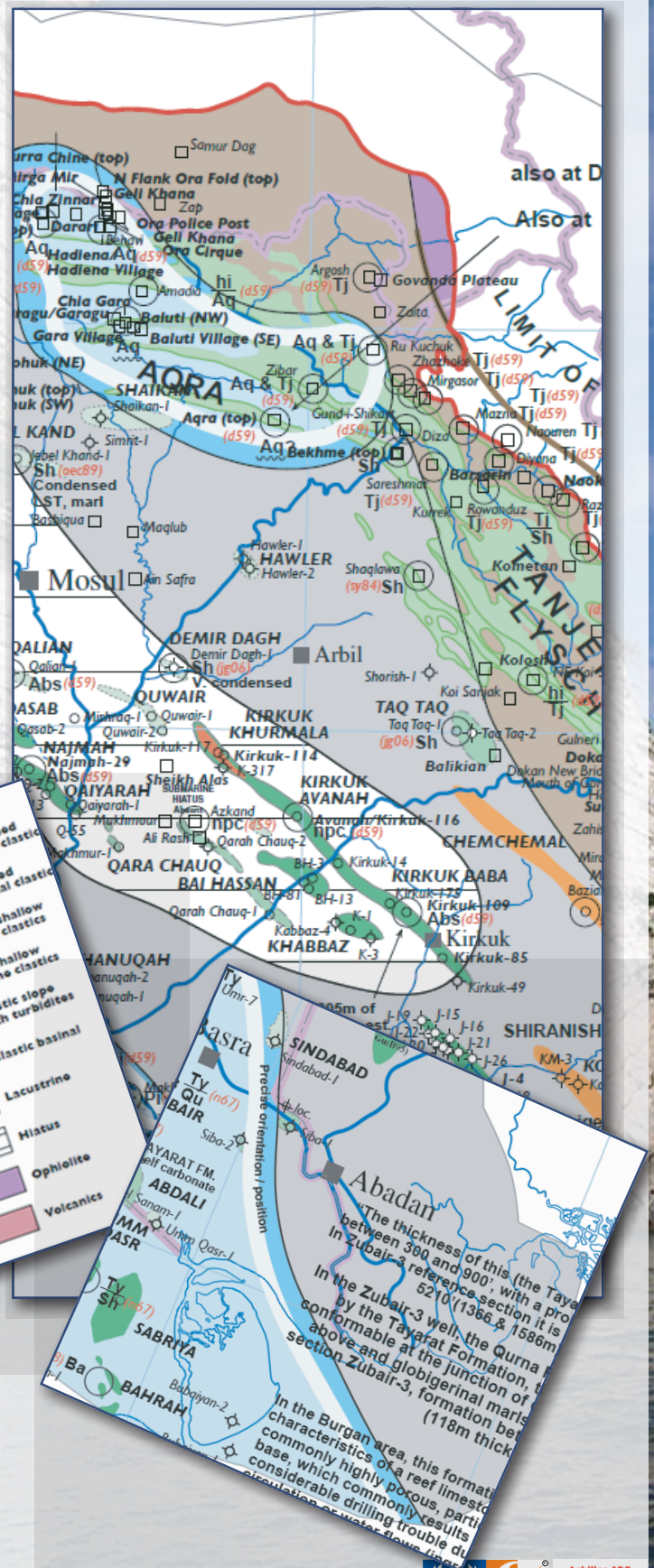
The maps have been constructed using data derived and collated from publicly available sources. They are available either as the **full set** (368 maps) or as **'best of'** subset (100 maps) with a correspondingly reduced price.

Facies polygons are available as a GIS database that has been developed in ArcGIS10.
